




For this activity, use your finest washable paints, a paintbrush, and a smock. Make sure the surface you use to do this activity is covered with newspaper before you begin.

Using red, yellow, and blue paints (the primary colors) see what colors you can create so by combining them below:




Now try to make your own color! What colors will you combine?




